Got a Good Idea? - Get a Grant!

TIGHRA has funding from the Scottish Government to carry out up to twelve workshops throughout rural Scotland on fundraising. The workshops must take place before the end of March 2009 and they will be facilitated by Judith McCullough or Paula Argo from TIGHRA.

What are the workshops about?

The workshops are designed to help groups understand:

- How to make a good funding application
- What ideas may achieve funding in Scotland
- Who can provide this funding

Who should attend?

The workshops are designed for community groups such as residents and tenants associations. We are also keen to include some workshops for groups in sheltered or supported housing, and for young tenants.

What form will the workshops take?

The workshops will run for two hours and will include some case study exercises as well as a PowerPoint presentation.

What do we need interested landlords to do?

If you would like to host a workshop in your area all we need you to do is:

Contact Paula or Judith at TIGHRA (see above) to agree a suitable date and discuss details.

Advertise the event to your groups and make arrangements for them to attend. (We suggest a minimum of 5 people and a maximum of 15 people per workshop).

Provide the venue and some light refreshments. The venue should have convenient electrical points, a flip chart and a screen or clear, neutral-coloured wall to show a presentation.

TIGHRA will provide: the facilitator, PowerPoint equipment, all handouts and the facilitator's travel and other expenses.

TIGHRA will not meet expenses for people attending the workshop.
